**SIGN UP AND PAY (CHECK MADE OUT TO PACK 1928) DURING 9/9/14 PACK MEETING.**

**BRING:** Sleeping bag, pillow, toiletries, towel and flashlight. Bug spray advisable. No carry-on food or drinks allowed. Cold showers are available. Separate sleeping quarters are available for male & female overnights. The program is conducted in a fun-spirited, but military manner - falling in, stowing your gear and following orders are all part of this unique and memorable experience. CLASS A uniforms required during travel and check-in. Class B otherwise.

**LOCATION/TRANSPORTATION/PARKING:** The USS Texas is located at the San Jacinto Battleground State Historic Site. Transportation will be provided and arranged by each Cub Scout's family. The Pack will not be providing organized transportation to/from the USS Texas.
